Dear Mayor and Councillors,

Maori Wards.

There has been request to sought public opinion on the subject of Maori Wards.

I would like to express my own.

I have been a New Zealander coming up 80 years. With this such experience, I can confidently provide a fair and substantiated opinion on this matter.

If you go back and look at the History of the Treaty signing in 1840, there seems to be a issue where the historical facts have since been altered somewhat.

There has been an extremist adjustment to the nature of the truth, and the current narrative is somewhat of a state of untruth facts.

When the treaty was signed, this gave the people of the land, our native brothers and sisters, the support and collaboration of the British Crown.

Since then, and a century or two later, New Zealanders live in a Democratic nation, and we all were one.

Maori, and Pakeha lived in a unified nation, and we did not differentiate between the two races. We were all Kiwis.

At some point, the establishment of a group who would advise and dictate further, known as the Waitangi Tribunal.

If you search this online, it is clear they are here to advise and make recommendations of claims from Maori, that relate to the crown's actions which breach promises made in the treaty. This industry has then since drained billions of dollars from the taxpayer for so called colonist oppression and discrimination against maori.


The treaty was intended to provide all people of New Zealand, Maori and Pakeha the same rights and protection under English Law.

The unison of our people of New Zealand has continued to be divided by the extremists who are part of the Tribunal, and then in turn filters down to other taxpayer funded organizations who are maorifying new zealand, and the latest being Co Governance assisted by Maori Wards.

I am now in a country, where if I speak my own thoughts, I am often referred to as being racist. I do not understand this, when we are all the same people, we have the same blood running through our veins, and we have the same opportunities as one another.

To our Local Mayor, and local councillors, the choice is clear to us all, that by continuing in engaging in this narrative, and allowing the divide between our people, by supporting the maori wards, i do feel that the racism will continue, not only for the Pakeha, but for the Maori as well. We are creating a divide of our people. This is not going to work. We must be all one nation, Kiwis, be it Maori, Pakeha, British, Irish, Chinese, or Indian.
