## The Process of Making the Chair

We designed and created the Generation Chair by incorporating various elements to depict two possible futures. We used different materials and symbols to show both the negative and positive outcomes of our actions regarding the climate crisis.

### Significance of Both Sides

#### Left Side:

- · Dried, brown grass: represents a future with continued neglect, where our environment suffers
- · Tree stumps: symbolise deforestation and loss of biodiversity
- · Factory: represents industrial pollution and its impact on air quality
- · Oil spill and rubbish in water: illustrate ocean pollution
- · Water marker: indicates rising sea levels due to climate change

#### Right Side:

- · Solar panels and wind turbines: signify the adoption of renewable energy sources
- · Vegetable garden: represents sustainable farming practices
- · Healthy trees: indicate thriving forests and biodiversity
- · Clean, low water levels: symbolise manageable soa levels
