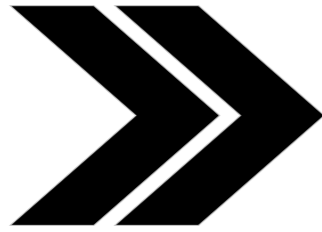


WHAT WE NEED TO TALK ABOUT TO LAND OUR VISION AND STRATEGY
